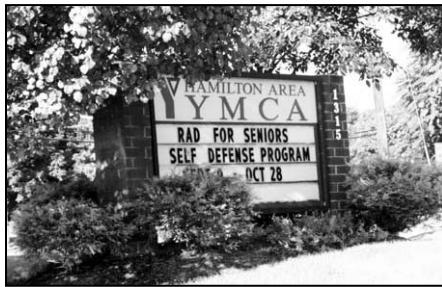


# NEWS TO KNOW
